After the completion of the merger between OSK and RHB Investment Bank in 2013, he was reassigned to oversee the Islamic capital market function for the merged entity and later the overall non-retail business development of RHB Islamic Bank. Yazit holds a Master Degree in Business Administration majoring in Finance conferred by University of Southern Queensland, Australia in 2003.
